

JEFFERSON CITY COUNCIL/MAYOR AGREEMENTS

The Council Members, after discussion, agreed to have the City Administrator research alternative methods to deliver City engineering services. Alternatives specifically mentioned were:

- Redefine position—clarify actual authority and responsibilities of the position
- Investigate an alternative position such as Public Works Director
- Investigate Outsourcing Engineering services via contract (s)
- Research alternative staffing methods for the Park/Rec. department

Consolidate the parks maintenance staff with public works maintenance staff - supervisory changes and staffing level changes may result

The Council Members, after discussion, agreed to have the City Administrator research the current Council Committee structure and its effectiveness.
